



- Re-Prioritize Goals Quickly






04 MAINTAINING OPERATIONS DURING

- Security Upgrades




05 PROJECT COMPONENTS

- 6500 SF Expansion and Repurpose of Gym to a Multipurpose Building
 - Convert gym to Multipurpose building
 - Added a Second floor-Office
 - New Pharmacy and ECT
 - New Elevator
 - New Fire Life Safety (FLS) and Mechanical Electrical Plumbing (MEP Systems







06 PROJECT COMPONENTS

- 9000 SF Child Adolescent Program (CAP) and 7600 SF of East Wing
 - Reactivated seven patient beds within CAP
 - Added 9 new patient beds in East Wing
 - Refinished all existing patient and toilet rooms
 - New Dining and Activity rooms and nurse station
 - New Fire Life Safety (FLS) and Mechanical Electrical Plumbing (MEP Systems
 - Anti-ligature and safe FFE, passive security for staff
